What we do

- Every employee undergoes mandatory safety training during onboarding, with regular refreshers to ensure updated knowledge and practices.
- > Management plays an integral role in safety meetings, ensuring that safety is not just a priority but a key factor in all decision-making processes.
- > We foster an open culture where employees can freely report hazards and incidents without fear of retaliation, promoting continuous improvement.
- External parties, including contractors and visitors, are provided with clear safety guidelines and are held to the same stringent safety standards as our employees.
- > We regularly conduct worker dialogs, surveys and assessments to identify potential risks and evaluate employees' perceptions of their health and safety conditions.

- Employees are directly involved in shaping safety policies and procedures, ensuring practical and effective solutions that reflect on-the-ground realities.
- > We continuously monitor and evaluate our health and safety management system through defined performance metrics, ensuring ongoing effectiveness and alignment with industry standards.
- A safety committee with representatives from all business units ensures that safety practices are consistently applied across the organization. Additionally, a designated safety officer is appointed at each business unit to oversee and manage their own compliance with safety guidelines.

Compliance and Implementation of Policy

This policy covers the Wrist Ship Supply Group and was developed in November 2024. All employees must keep themselves informed about and follow this policy, and remain flexible to adjustments as deemed necessary or advisable.

Annual reviews of this policy are intended.
